



Welcome Sisters to our first “Sisters’ Bible Study!” We hope you are spiritually enriched from the upcoming lessons and studies.

The study is opened to sisters 18 years and older. On the first day of our session, each sister is asked to have her camera on.

The purpose of our Sisters’ Bible Study is to 1) Increase our knowledge of the Holy scriptures, 2) Improve our relationship with our Husband, Christ; and 3) To deepen our understanding of the role of holy women.

This is an interactive study, and no sister is superior in the knowledge of God’s Word. If so, there is no need for you to attend this study. Therefore, respect will be exhibited to each participant. We want to continuously learn, and come into the true knowledge of God Almighty, JEHOVAH.

Each sister is encouraged to study the assigned chapters in the Bible, King James Version 1611; and be prepared to ask and answer questions. We study to please God, and not man. II Timothy 2:15 reads, “Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.” Sisters, “Study at your pace.” You will never be left behind; except, you cease from 1) Following JEHOVAH; and 2) Studying His Word (example, the 10 virgins, Matthew 25:1-13).

Precept Scriptures:

Isaiah 28:9-10, “⁹Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the

breasts. ¹⁰ For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little.”

Psalms 119:4, 104, “⁴ Thou hast commanded us to keep thy precepts diligently. ¹⁰⁴ Through thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way.”

Isaiah 34:16, “¹⁶ Seek ye out of the book of the Lord, and read: no one of these shall fail, none shall want her mate: for my mouth it hath commanded, and his spirit it hath gathered them.”

Added Precept Scriptures:

Proverbs 6:16-17(a), “¹⁶ These six things doth the Lord hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: ¹⁷ A proud look...”

Proverbs 29:23, ²³ A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.

As we study the Book of Esther, Additions to Esther (and other chapters in the Bible), let the Holy Spirit lead, guide and direct us.
